Here's a sneak peek of next week

Bible: We will continue to talk about the ministry of Christ and learn that all Christians should be missionaries.

Language Arts: Parts of speech continued.

Math: Chapter 7: Division. Students will divide by 2 and 3 and connect division with subtraction and multiplication.

Reading: Students will identify the topic sentences, supporting sentences, and the closing sentence of a paragraph. Students will also answer comprehension questions.

Science: Students will investigate different types and stages of matter.

Spelling: Unit 14: Open and closed syllables. An open syllable ends in a vowel and the vowel sound is usually long. A closed syllable ends in at least one consonant and the vowel sound is usually short.

Social Studies: We will be continuing our unit on maps. We will be able name and locate the major oceans and the continents. We will also recognize lines of latitude and longitude.
