Earnings from work:

- Wages, salaries, tips, commissions
- Net income from self-owned businesses and farms
- Strike benefits, unemployment compensation and worker's compensation

Welfare/child support/alimony:

- Public assistance payments/welfare benefits (TANF, General Assistance, General Relief, etc.)
- Alimony and child support payments

NOTE: Food stamps and FDPIR benefits are not included in income

- Pensions, retirement income, veteran's benefits
- Social security
